Trion Navarchon Square is dedicated to the memory of the admirals Kyriakos of England, Demetrios of Russia and Konstantinos of France.

The square was constructed in the time of the governor of Greece Ioannis Kapodistrias.

In the middle of the square is the funeral monument containing the remains of the 13 Mykonians who were killed during the 1826 battle of Mykonos.

There are many splendid neo-classical buildings in the square, the building which is the pharmacy was the town's first pharmacy.
